## **Funding Resources Available to Local Churches for Accessibility Projects**

#### **Denominational Grants**

Funding is available through the DisAbility Ministries Committee of the United Methodist Church (DMC). Limited grants may assist with funding accessibility and inclusion projects. The 2022 Grant application window is January 15<sup>th</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>. An application form that includes requirements can be downloaded at the DMC website<sup>1</sup>.

United Methodist churches seeking to develop or enhance ministries with Deaf or hard-of-hearing persons may apply for a <u>Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing Ministries</u><sup>3</sup> grant.

### **Potentially Available Conference Grants**

- California- Pacific Conference Disability Ministries Task Force offers <u>Disability</u>
  Grants.<sup>4</sup>
- **Holston Conference** offers <u>one-time grants</u><sup>5</sup> for making renovations or providing equipment to increase full accessibility to local church structures or programs.
- Illinois Great Rivers Conference offers <u>Disability Awareness Grants</u><sup>6</sup>.
- Indiana Conference's United Methodist Foundation offers <u>Facilities Grants</u><sup>7</sup> for accessibility.
- **Iowa Conference,** Commission on Ministry with People with Disabilities offers Disability Seed Grants. Check the <u>Commission website</u><sup>8</sup> for a grant application.
- **Minnesota Conference**: Seed money <u>Grants</u><sup>9</sup> may be available for new ministries that reach new people, help the congregation grow in love of God and neighbor, and heal a broken world.
- **Northern Illinois Conference**: Contact the <u>Committee on Accessibility Ministries<sup>10</sup></u> via the committee page for more information.
- South Carolina Conference offers Accessibility to Worship Grants. 11
- **Virginia Conference:** The <u>Commission on Disabilities</u><sup>12</sup> helps fund accessibility and program grants.

• Western Pennsylvania Conference: Conference Committee on Disability Concerns<sup>13</sup> grants are temporarily suspended due to lack of funds.

Other Conferences may have resources to help their churches. Check your Conference website or contact your Disability Concerns committee, Director of Connectional Ministries, and/or conference United Methodist Foundation for information.

The Southeastern Jurisdiction maintains the <u>Renfro Trust Fund</u><sup>14</sup> which has grants for rural UM churches within the Southeast.
